Harold "Bud" Magathan - Aug 22, 1941 - Sep 4, 2025. Sadly, Bud passed away recently. He was a Navy Veteran, and Past Commander and Chaplain of Post 346, and as a son of a Veteran, was also a Member and Chaplain of SAL Squadron 346. A true gentleman who will be missed. He was among the first to welcome me and shake my hand when I joined 346 in 1997.

We took part in the annual Run for the Fallen. I covered two locations, plus a third in support. Our Post Family covered six Honor locations, honoring seven fallen warriors, in Spring Lake, Belmar, Avon, and Bradley Beach. If you've never witnessed this event, be sure to look for it at the end of next September. Runners hit the pavement from Cape May to the Vietnam Memorial in Holmdel, some 174 miles, over four days, stopping every mile or to honor a US fallen warrior and his or her family. The last day of the event is also the day we honor Gold Star Mothers. Thanks to our 346 Family for being part of this event.
